Adult Skate 15+ | \$5 | \$3 Senior

An adult public skate designed for lap skating. No on-ice supervision. Helmets are recommended.

Parent & Tot (Children 5Y & under) | \$5

All Children must wear a CSA-approved helmet during this session. Strollers with clean wheels are welcome. Strollers, chairs, and homemade devices are not allowed as skate aids. Children are free with admission of one adult. No on-ice supervision. Shared ice with 6 & under stick n' puck.

Ticket Ice | \$5

Pay as you go. Must be a Skate Canada member before participating in the program. No on-ice staff supervision. Coach must be present.

Public Skating | \$5 Adult | \$3 Senior | Child & Youth \$3

Everyone is welcome to this general lap session. Public skating rules apply. Staff supervised.

Stick N' Puck Programs \$5

Practice and develop skating, stick handling and passing skills in a non-competitive environment. All participants are required to wear a CSA-approved hockey helmet. Adult must be on the ice. Participants must have a hockey stick. Games are not permitted. Bring your own pucks. 6 & under stick' n puck is shared ice with parent & tot.

Shinny Programs | \$5 Adult | \$3 Senior | Child & Youth \$3

Non-contact, programs for a variety of age groups. Full hockey equipment is required, including a CSA approved helmet. No on-ice supervision.
